THE 2010 REUNION OF PORT ORCHARD CHURCH OF CHRIST

Saturday, September 11, 2010

Members of the Church of Christ first began meeting together in the fledgling community of Sidney, Washington (later to become Port Orchard, Washington) on January 11, 1884. More members moved into the area over the next several years and on December 6, 1888 the church was officially incorporated as Sidney Church of Christ, later to be known as Annapolis Church of Christ, then later still, as Port Orchard Church of Christ.

Over the years many people have held membership in this church. Because of our close proximity to Puget Sound Naval Shipyard many Navy families worship with this church during the tour of duty here, some chose to make their permanent home in Port Orchard, Bremerton, and larger Kitsap County after their military service was completed. I suppose there are former members of Port Orchard Church of Christ now living all over the U.S. and several foreign countries.

This church has been a part of the history of hundreds and hundreds of people. I just wonder how many people there are alive on earth today who once were members of this church. And I wonder how many of them we can find. And I wonder how many of them we can get to come back and visit with us. And even if we can't get them to come back and visit, maybe we can get their present addresses and maybe even a brief update of their stories to share on that wonderful day.
