PORT ORCHARD CHURCH OF CHRIST FAMILY REUNION Saturday, September 11, 2010

Marking our heritage here, William and Minerva Jane Cline came first. The year was 1884. Soon additional family members and other settlers moved into the fledgling pioneer community of Sidney, Washington. In 1887 a small group made up of some of these settlers came together for the first time to "read the Scriptures, exhort each other as best they could, offer prayers and praise to the Lord and to celebrate His last supper." This marked the beginning of what is now Port Orchard Church of Christ.

In 1888 the church was officially incorporated as Sidney Church of Christ. Later it would be known as Annapolis Church of Christ. Later still, and continuing to the present, as Port Orchard Church of Christ.

So if you identify the beginning of this church with the time Christians first began meeting together publicly for worship here in this community, this church will be 123 years old in November of this year, 2010.

So it is a good time for a reunion.
