## **PRAYER SWEAT AT BLAIR'S**

**Wednesday, August 11th, 6:00 P.M.**

A special prayer sweat has been scheduled for Wednesday evening, August 11th, beginning at 6:00 p.m. Matt Tibbles and Federal Way have requested this prayer time but all are invited.

We have held several of these sweats over the last three years and many of your teens have asked to be notified whenever we plan on having one.

We will also get the word out over facebook in the coming days. If your teens want to come but not actually go into the prayer sweat they can still participate and remain around the campfire, which is just fine.

We always attempt to maintain a time of singing and quiet fellowship as the prayer rounds are going on inside the sweat lodge. The sitting area around the fire pit has room for 35 to 40 people to sit comfortably. We can always increase the number by bringing in extra chairs.

We won't provide dinner but maybe smores toward the end that they can roast over the fire.

Everyone attending is reminded to bring their own appropriate attire for the prayer sweat (shorts and T-shirt), a water bottle, and towel. Extra water bottles will be on hand and a jug to refill bottles.

We will run several rounds so many can arrive later depending on their schedule and we'll find room in the later rounds. You can begin arriving as early as 5:00 p.m. I will be out around the fire stoking the flames heating the rocks. We will have a volleyball net set up for anyone who wants to come early and play.

If anyone from the Port Orchard area wants to bring over some firewood on Tuesday or Wednesday I wouldn't mind it. We are rather low and need some more wood.
