

Woman at the Well

John 4:6-26

(Jesus is tired and thirsty as he is sitting on a rock near the well. The Samaritan woman approaches from the other side.)

Jesus **Would you give me a drink of water?**

Woman **Why are you asking me for a drink? *(She is shocked)***
Your people refuse to have anything to do with my people.

Jesus **If you only knew the generosity of God and who I am you would ask me for a drink and I would give you living water, water that will satisfy you for life.**

Woman **Sir, give me some of this living water.**

Jesus **Go get your husband.**

Woman **I have no husband.**

Jesus **You have had five husbands and the man you are with now is not your husband.**

Woman **Are you a prophet? *(pause)* Why do your people say we must worship in Jerusalem, while mine say to worship at this mountain.**

Jesus **The time is coming when all people can worship God in Spirit and in Truth anywhere in this world.**

Woman ***(Doubting)* I know when the Messiah comes He will explain all this.**

Jesus **I am He.**

Woman ***(turning/moving towards the car or crowd as she walks off to her village)***
Could this be the Messiah? Could he be the one? He told me all about my life.

(As the woman walks off the lights dim and Jesus is reseated near the well.)
